



Camp Discovery

GENERAL INFORMATION

Check in (8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.)

MONDAYS ONLY: Check in at Front Desk

Tuesday thru Friday a parent or guardian will be expected to sign in their child on the west side of the Museum (S.W. 5th Avenue). A child may participate in Camp Discovery programs only when camp fees are processed and the following camp forms are completed:

- Registration Form
- Code of Conduct Form
- Camp Policy and Emergency Form
- Subway Lunch Request

Check out (4:15 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.)

Any child being checked in or out between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:15 p.m. must go to the concierges desk. Each afternoon, check out will be at the west side of the building at the back gate. **A parent or guardian must present photo identification** and sign the log sheet at the Camp Discovery check out desk on the west side of the Museum. Only adults indicated on the Camp Policy and Emergency Information Form will be allowed to check out a camper.

Before (8:00-9:00 a.m.) and After care (5:00-6:00 p.m.)

A daily fee of \$5 is charged per child for before/after care and includes a light snack, science games, puzzles, crafts, and educational videos. **An additional fee of \$5 per child for each additional 15 minutes of care will be charged after 6:00 p.m.**

Lunches and Snacks

Campers may bring their own bag lunches that do not require refrigeration, or indicate their preference for a Subway "camper's lunch pack" **one week before camp**. A simple snack and water will be provided twice a day. Campers may also bring snacks from home, especially if they have dietary restrictions including kosher. Please do not send money for snack machines.

What to wear and what to bring

Campers should wear comfortable clothing that is suitable for indoors, outdoors and getting dirty. Shorts and t-shirts are recommended. Sneakers or closed-toe shoes are required. No shoes with wheels, please. Children should be prepared to spend short periods of time outside and participate daily in physical activity. It is recommended that children bring insect repellent, sunblock, and a plastic water bottle.

What not to bring

Cash, toys, electronics, gameboys and other valuables should not be brought to Camp. The Museum is not responsible for any personal items lost or stolen.

Friday is Explore Store Day

Campers will have an opportunity to visit the Explore Store on Friday morning. If you'd like your child to visit the Store, please give them a little money to spend when you drop them off on Friday. If you select not to have them participate we will provide another activity for them.
